Background : The Covid-19 pandemic and African Horse Sickness (AHS) have impacted the equestrian activities and movement of horses.

Indeed, we need to explore the possibility of organizing the Digitalization Competition without gathering of athletes and movement of horses.

**Method of Competition
Show Jumping** : All the venue will put up a formal show jumping course designed by the official course designer.

The show jumping course must be identical, same height, same distance, and same fence element.

The competition will run concurrently, the judges will be judging from the EAM office comprising of President, Jury (1) calling, Jury (2) official time.

The final results will be announced by the above judges and is final.

All the competitions will be broadcasted/streamed online using Zoom and 2 phone cameras will be placed at judge's box.

Minimum 2 stewards, 2 flaggers and bell man at the venue.

The bell man will walk the course live and witnessed by the judges at EAM office.

Ambulance and paramedic are compulsory for all show jumping competitions.

Dressage : This competition will be judged online via zoom.

The athletes will ride their own horses' various clubs.

The dressage judges will judge the event from the EAM office.

The size of dressage arena is 20m x 60m.

The bellman at the venue will ring the bell by the instruction of the judges at the EAM office.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF COMPETITION

Rules of Competition : The competition will be run under the rules of FEI and rules of **Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM)**.

Sand and open arena.

Prize Giving Ceremony : Rosettes, medal, certificate and plague medal for horse owner will be send to the riders by courier.
All prize money will be transferred online.

Dress Code : All riders are expected to wear a correctly fastened, helmet and fitted hard hat when mounted at all times, riding boots and white collar shirt.

The Organizer Alter advertised times if necessary.

Reserves the Right to	: Cancel any event or class. Divide any class. Refuse any entries.
Veterinary Scratching	: Entries cancelled after the entries closing date must be verified with a Vet. medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee, provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of any event.
Waiver Forms and Acknowledgement Forms and EAM Membership form	: Please return all waiver and acknowledgement forms by Entries Closing Date. Competitors without signed forms will not be allowed to compete. The waiver and acknowledgement forms are attached as Appendix 2 . The membership application form attach as Appendix 3
Administration Fee	: All participants require to pay RM100.00 each to assist in organizing cost. These fees must pay direct to the venue organizing committee.
Entry Fees	: All entry fees must be paid prior to the start of the competition. Late entry will be charged double. No refund will be made for rider without or cancel the entry Without Veterinary Scratching.
Horses	: All horses are required to register with EAM. Those horses not register with EAM of FEI are not allowed to compete.
Rider	: EAM competition open to all EAM members and would like to encourage all riders register as individual member of EAM.
Medical Control Programmer	: The executive committee of Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM) has decided that Usains Biomics Laboratory Services Sdn Bhd is the official laboratory to test all Equine Anti-Doping in the National level. The participants refuse to allow their horses to be tested will be immediately disqualified.
Covid-19 SOP	: The Covid-19 SOP shall be applied in this competition as follows • Measurement of temperature • Wearing face mask at all time except mounted on horse • Registration at the entrance • Social Distancing • No Spectators • Non compliance of the SOP may result removal from the venue. • All participants must be fully vaccinated • Those no vaccinated must do a RTK test at the entrance • Participants under 17 must be accompany by the parents or guardians with full vaccinated.
